SENATE AMENDMENT " A" to H.P. 919, L.D. 1316, Bill, "An Act to Clarify Board Membership Qualifications and Make Necessary Fee Adjustments to Meet Board and Departmental Operating Expenses for the State Board of Licensure for Professional Foresters"

Amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "\$5004." in the first paragraph by striking out all of the last sentence (page 1, lines 41 and 42 in L.D.).


Further amend the bill by inserting after section 5 the following:

'Sec. 6. Transition; board members. Any member serving on the State Board of Licensure for Professional Foresters on the effective date of this Act shall serve until the term for which that member was appointed expires.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

The original bill amended an existing section of law to reduce the terms of members of the State Board of Licensure for Professional Foresters from 5 to 3 years. In a technical error, the bill stated that this was to take effect with the effective date of the section. This amendment provides for a correct transition provision.
