COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 493, L.D. 1331, Bill, "An Act Regarding Sprinkler Systems in New Buildings"

Amend the bill by inserting before the statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

This bill requires that as of January 1, 1992, sprinkler systems be installed in all hotels of more than 2 stories or other buildings higher than 75 feet. The additional workload and administrative costs associated with a minimal number of new cases filed in District Court as a result of the new violation will be absorbed within the budgeted resources of the Judicial Department.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

The amendment adds a fiscal note to the bill.
