An Act to Amend the Salaries of the Knox County Commissioners and
Officers.

(EMERGENCY)



Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, it has become necessary to revise the salaries of certain county officers; and

Whereas, it is desired to have these revisions retroactive to January 1, 1991; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 30-A MRSA §2, sub-§1, ¶F, as repealed and replaced by PL 1989, c. 928, is amended to read:

F. Knox County:

(1) Commissioners

(a) District 1	\$4,000	\$4,000
(b) District 2	4,000	4,000
(c) District 3	4,000	4,000
(d) Chair differential	300	300 350

(2) Treasurer 19,712 20,304

(3) Sheriff 30,420 31,333

(4) Judge of Probate 12,000 ~~12,000~~ 12,360

(5) Register of Probate 17,644 18,174

(6) Register of Deeds 19,712 20,304

(7) Jail Project Captain 9,000

Sec. 2. Jail construction project funds. The salary for the position of jail project captain is paid from the jail construction project funds.

2 **Sec. 3. Retroactivity.** This Act is retroactive to January 1,
1991.

4 **Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited in the
6 preamble, this Act takes effect when approved.

8 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

10 This bill increases the salaries of the treasurer, sheriff,
12 judge of probate, register of probate and register of deeds for
Knox County. The bill also provides to the chair of the Knox
14 County commissioners an increase in salary and clarifies that the
salary for the position of jail project captain is paid from the
jail construction project funds.
