10	This bill increases the salaries of the treasurer, sheriff, judge of probate, register of probate and register of deeds for
12	Knox County. The bill also provides to the chair of the Knox County commissioners an increase in salary and clarifies that the
14	salary for the position of jail project captain is paid from the jail construction project funds.
