COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 502, L.D. 1340

The estimated cost of sending this bond issue out to referendum will vary according to the total number of referenda. The estimated cost to the Secretary of State if one to 6 referenda are enacted is \$95,000. Each additional referendum costs an additional \$6,500.'

This amendment increases the bond issue to \$16,500,000, allocates \$2,700,000 for capital construction of public drinking water supplies and \$13,800,000 for capital construction of water pollution control facilities, increases the length of the bond and adds a fiscal note to the bill.
