COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 503, L.D. 1341, Bill, "An Act to Amend Various Provisions of the Electricians' Examining Board Laws"

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 8 (page 2, lines 3 and 4 in L.D.)

Further amend the bill by inserting after section 13 the following:

'Sec. 14. Allocation. The following funds are allocated from Other Special Revenue funds to carry out the purposes of this Act.

Provides funds to promulgate rules regarding inactive licenses.'

Further amend the bill by renumbering the sections to read consecutively.

Further amend the bill at the end before the statement of fact by inserting the following:

Other Funds \$2,000

2 This bill will require the Department of Professional and
3 Financial Regulation to promulgate rules regarding inactive
4 electricians' licenses. An allocation of \$2,000 in fiscal year
5 1991-92 of available resources is required by the Electricians'
6 Examining Board to cover the costs associated with rulemaking.

8 The additional work load and administrative costs associated
9 with a minimal number of new cases filed in District Court as a
10 result of the violation will be absorbed within the budgeted
11 resources of the Judicial Department. The collection of
12 additional fines will increase General Fund revenue by a minor
13 amount.'

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STATEMENT OF FACT

18 The original bill, among its many provisions, requires that
19 a utility corporation require proof that an electrical
20 installation has been inspected before connecting power.
21 Further, it removes the exception of one-family or 2-family
22 dwellings from the permit and inspection requirements of the law
23 regulating electricians.

26 The amendment replaces the provision that exempts one-family
27 or 2-family dwellings from these permit and inspection
28 requirements.

28

30 The amendment also adds an allocation section and a fiscal
note to the bill.
