26	Misery, T2 R7 BKP WKR; and Sapling, T1 R7 BKP WKR, by Private and Special Law 1989, chapter 33, must be administered by the State

36	This amendment replaces the bill. Section 1 of the amendment reestablishes the Township of Misery-Sapling Gore,
38	which was absorbed into the townships of Parlin Pond, Misery and Sapling in 1989.

4.5	Section 2 of the amendment addresses the problems of record
42	keeping and mapping that Private and Special Law 1989, chapter 33 resolved. It provides that all record keeping, maintenance of
