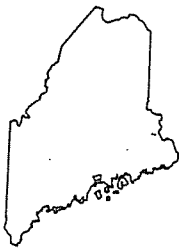

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An Act to Amend the Maine Health Program.

3 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

4 22 MRSA §3189, sub-§3, ¶A, as enacted by PL 1989, c. 588, Pt.  
5 A, §43, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

6 A. Except as provided in paragraph B and subsection 5,  
7 persons whose household income is 150% or less of the  
8 federal poverty level are eligible to participate in the  
9 program and to receive benefits in accordance with this  
10 section.

13 STATEMENT OF FACT

15 This bill makes the Maine Health Program available to more  
16 people by increasing household income to 150% or less of the  
17 federal poverty level to make them eligible for the program.
