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An Act to Grant Enforcement Powers to Sewer Districts.

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2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

4 Sec. 1. 38 MRSA §1253-A is enacted to read:

6 §1253-A. Enforcement powers

8 The boards of trustees of sewer districts have the same  
10 powers of enforcement that are granted to municipal officials in  
12 Title 30-A, section 4452.

14 Sec. 2. 38 MRSA §1254, as enacted by PL 1981, c. 466, §13, is  
16 amended to read:

18 §1254. Effective date

20 This ~~chapter~~ shall Section 1251 and section 1252,  
22 subsections 1, 2, 3, 4 and 7 take effect January 1, 1983, except  
24 that section. Section 1252, subsections 5 and 6 and section 1253  
26 shall take effect January 1, 1982. Section 1253-A takes effect  
28 October 1, 1991.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill grants to the boards of trustees of sewer districts the same enforcement powers that are granted to municipal officials in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 30-A, section 4452.
