**An Act Regarding Bow Hunting.**

---



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

12 MRSA §7102, sub-§5, ¶B, as amended by PL 1989, c. 913, Pt.  
A, §3, is further amended to read:

B. If a person takes a deer with bow and arrow during the open season on deer, that person is precluded from further hunting for deer during that year, except that the person may continue to hunt for and take one additional deer by bow and arrow in any municipality or part of a municipality in which the discharge of firearms during the deer hunting season is prohibited by municipal ordinance.

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill permits persons who have taken a deer with bow and arrow either during the special bow and arrow season on deer or during the regular deer season to hunt for and take one additional deer with bow and arrow in municipalities that have closed all or part of their territory to the discharge of firearms during the hunting season on deer.
