An Act to Increase the Personal Needs Allowance for Certain Elderly Persons.

	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

	The department shall administer a program of medical

	disability or age, and who do not have sufficient income to meet
14	the per resident payment rate for boarding home care, including an amount for personal needs of at least \$39 <u>\$50</u> a month.
