IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE

An Act to Clarify the Authority of the Department of Transportation to Acquire Property for Environmental Mitigation Purposes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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23 MRSA §153, sub-§7, as enacted by PL 1987, c. 267, §3, is amended to read:

7. Other projects. improve and maintain Construct, transportation projects as directed by law and provide mitigation for existing or potential environmental effects of any transportation projects.

STATEMENT OF FACT

Federal and state environmental laws and regulations require that the Department of Transportation set aside property to mitigate impacts associated with transportation projects. This bill clarifies the department's authority to acquire property to mitigate environmental impacts.

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
