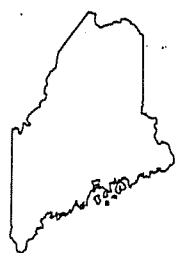

An Act to Require Hunters of Upland Game to Wear Blaze Orange.



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

12 MRSA §7456, sub-§7, is enacted to read:

6 7. Hunting without hunter orange clothing. A person is
8 guilty of hunting without hunter orange clothing if that person
10 hunts with firearms during bird season and fails to wear an
12 article of solid-colored hunter orange clothing that is in good
14 and serviceable condition and visible from all sides. This
16 subsection does not apply to persons hunting waterfowl.

This bill requires hunters who hunt upland game to wear
