COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 962, L.D. 1389, Bill, "An Act to Increase Hunting Opportunity by Allowing Sunday Hunting in Unorganized Townships"

Amend the bill by adding at the end and before the statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

Allowing Sunday hunting in unorganized townships may increase General Fund revenue to the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife from additional sales of hunting licenses. The amount of the additional revenue can not be determined at this time. Costs associated with additional enforcement responsibilities will be absorbed by the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife utilizing existing budgeted resources.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

The amendment, which is the minority report of the Joint Standing Committee on Fisheries and Wildlife, adds a fiscal note to the bill.
