### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE

An Act to Increase Hunting Opportunity by Allowing Sunday Hunting in Unorganized Townships.



	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7406, sub-§4, as enacted by PL 1979, c. 420,
4	§1, is amended to read:
6	4. Hunting on Sunday. A person is guilty, except as provided in subsection 20, paragraph C, of hunting on Sunday if
8	he that person hunts wild animals or wild birds on Sunday.
10	Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §7406, sub-§20, ¶C is enacted to read:
12	C. Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection 4, a person may hunt wild animals and wild birds on Sunday in any
14	unorganized or deorganized township.
16	Sec. 3. 12 MRSA §7945, as enacted by PL 1979, c. 420, $\S$ 1, is amended to read:
18	§7945. Possession of firearms on Sunday
20	
22	Possession of firearms in the fields or forests or on the waters or ice within any organized or incorporated city or town in the State er-in-a-motor-vehicle-being-operated-on-an-unpaved
24	highway-or-road-lecated-in-an-unorganized-township on Sunday is prima facie evidence of a violation of section 7406, subsection
26	4, unless:
28	1. Firearm covered. The firearm is carried, securely wrapped, in a complete cover;
30	2. Firearm fastened. The firearm is fastened in a case; or

34	3. Firearm in pieces. The firearm is carried in at least 2 separate pieces in such a manner that it sannet can not be fired, unless the separate pieces are joined together. For the purpose
36	of this subsection, a clip, magazine or cylinder of a firearm
38	shall is not be considered a piece of the firearm.
40	STATEMENT OF FACT
42	This bill is to legalize Sunday hunting in unorganized townships. Any person with a valid Maine hunting license would
44	be allowed to hunt any wild bird or wild animal on Sunday during the open season on that species in unorganized and deorganized
46	areas of the State in accordance with all other applicable laws
48	and regulations. This would encourage people to travel away from urban areas for purposes of hunting and, at the same time,
20	provide additional hunting opportunity for Maine residents who

are often required to work the other six days of the week.
