16	Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting
18	the following:
20	'An Act Concerning Access to Maine Veterans' Homes'
22	Further amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the statement of fact and inserting in
24	its place the following:
26	' 37-B MRSA §601, as amended by PL 1989, c. 502, Pt. A, §141, is further amended to read:
28	§601. Home established; purpose
30	There shall-be are established public homes for veterans in
32	Maine known as "Maine Veterans' Homes." In addition to the presently existing home located in Augusta, a 120-bed home
34	located in southern Maine and a home, not to exceed 60 beds, located in Aroostook County, may be constructed if federal
36	Veterans' Administration funds are available to meet part of the costs of each facility for construction or operation. The board
38	of trustees shall plan and develop these additional homes and may use any funds available for those purposes, except for the
40	Augusta facility's funded depreciation account. The primary purpose of the homes shall-be is to provide support and care for
42	honorably discharged veterans who served in the United States Armed Forces during wartime, including the Korean Conflict and
44	the Vietnam War. The homes must give priority in admissions to veterans who served during wartime, but may admit veterans who
46	did not serve during wartime if space is available.

FISCAL NOTE

This bill will expand the number of veterans eligible to be 4 residents at the Maine Veterans' Homes by allowing veterans who did not serve during wartime to be admitted on a space-available б basis. This may result in future requests for General Fund appropriations from the Maine Veterans' Homes to meet the demand 8 for additional space. 10 STATEMENT OF FACT 12 This amendment deletes from the bill provisions relating to 14 access to the Veterans' Memorial Cemetery. It also permits the 16 Maine Veterans' Homes to admit veterans who did not serve during wartime, if space is available, provided that veterans who served during wartime are given priority. 18
