IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE

An Act to Provide Confidentiality of Proprietary Data Provided to State Agencies.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

5 MRSA §1890-B, sub-§4 is enacted to read:

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4. Confidentiality. Computer programs, associated
6 documentation and bench mark test results that are provided to a state agency by an independent vendor or contractor under an
8 agreement by which the material remains the property of the vendor or contractor and the state agency obtains a limited
10 license for its use is confidential and must not be open for public inspection.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill permits proprietary information from private 18 sources to be retained by state agencies as confidential.

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
