IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE

Resolve, Requiring the Maine State Housing Authority to Study Continuing Care Retirement Communities and Life Care Communities.

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Study of continuing care retirement communities and life care communities. Resolved: That the Maine State Housing Authority shall study the development of continuing care retirement communities and life care communities in the State and submit its report to the Joint Standing Committee on Banking and Insurance by February 1, 1992. A copy of the report must be sent to the Office of the Executive Director of the Legislative Council. The report must analyze the failure of continuing care retirement communities and life care communities to be developed in the State and must include a comparison of the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 24-A, chapter 73 with similar legislation in The report must also include recommendations for other states. stimulating the development of continuing care retirement communities and life care communities and must specify the risks that such development would present for consumers.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

This resolve requires the Maine State Housing Authority to study the development of continuing care communities and life care communities in the State.
