COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 527, L.D. 1405, Bill, "An Act to Provide Confidentiality for the Records of Individuals Who Receive Funds from a Community Development Program Created Pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 30-A, Chapter 205"

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

This bill establishes a civil violation and ensures that records of individuals who receive assistance from a community development program remain confidential. The additional work load and administrative costs associated with a minimal number of new cases filed in District Court as a result of the new violation will be absorbed within the budgeted resources of the Judicial Department. There will also be a minor increase in revenue to the General Fund.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment adds a fiscal note to the bill.
