STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment deletes the word "Memorial" from the proposed name for the bridge over the Piscataqua River on Interstate 95. The bridge would be called the "David H. Stevens Bridge." The amendment also repeals the resolve on July 1, 1994 if New Hampshire does not enact similar legislation.
