COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 530, L.D. 1408, "Resolve, to Name the Interstate Bridge over the Piscataqua River the "David H. Stevens Memorial Bridge""

Amend the resolve by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'Resolve, to Name the Interstate Bridge over the Piscataqua River the "David H. Stevens Bridge"'

Further amend the resolve by striking out everything after the title and inserting in its place the following:

Sec. 1. David H. Stevens Bridge. Resolved: That the bridge spanning the Piscataqua River on Interstate 95 between Maine and New Hampshire be named the "David H. Stevens Bridge" and that a plaque be erected by the Department of Transportation near the bridge in commemoration of David Stevens' many years of dedicated service to his state and country; and be it further

Sec. 2. Repeal. Resolved: That this resolve is repealed on July 1, 1994, if the State of New Hampshire has not enacted similar legislation; and be it further

Sec. 3. Effective date. Resolved: That this resolve becomes effective when the State of New Hampshire enacts similar legislation.

FISCAL NOTE

Costs associated with naming a bridge spanning the Piscataqua River of Interstate 95 the "David H. Stevens Bridge," including the erection of a plaque, will be absorbed by the Department of Transportation utilizing existing budgeted resources.!

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STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment deletes the word "Memorial" from the proposed name for the bridge over the Piscataqua River on Interstate 95. The bridge would be called the "David H. Stevens Bridge." The amendment also repeals the resolve on July 1, 1994 if New Hampshire does not enact similar legislation.
