18	court must make a finding that the property loss is specifically related to that case.'

22	Further amend the bill by inserting before the statement of fact the following:

26	'FISCAL NOTE
20	This bill broadens the definition of property loss in
28	drug-related criminal violations. There may be an increase in revenue to the General Fund as a result of court-awarded
30	restitution to the State's law enforcement agency in an amount that can not be estimated at this time.'
32	chat can not be estimated at this time.
34	STATEMENT OF FACT
36	This amendment clarifies that "buy money" used by law
38	enforcement agencies may be recovered through restitution only if the court makes a finding that the loss of the property was
40	specifically related to the case for which the restitution is ordered.
42	This amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
