### An Act to Prevent Financial Gain by Convicted Drug Offenders.

	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	17-A MRSA §1322, sub-§3, ¶D, as amended by PL 1989, c. 872,
4	§5 and c. 924, §13, is further amended to read:
6	D. "Property loss" means the value of property taken from the victim, or of property destroyed or otherwise broken or
8	harmed. A property loss includes the value of taxes or other obligations due to the government that have not been
10	paid. <u>"Property loss" also includes, in cases involving a</u> violation of chapter 45, the value of money or other
12	<u>consideration given or offered in exchange for scheduled</u> <u>drugs by a law enforcement officer or another at the</u>
14	<u>direction of a law enforcement officer that are not, in</u> <u>fact, recovered by the State at the time of sentencing,</u>
