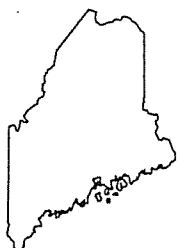

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An Act to Require Disclosure of the Per Therm Price of Propane Gas.

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2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

4 10 MRSA c. 308 is enacted to read:

6 CHAPTER 308

8 PROPANE GAS

10 §1681. Requirement for suppliers of propane gas to give  
notice of unit price of propane gas

12 1. Propane gas. A retail seller of propane gas shall  
14 notify a person who has requested a gas delivery of the price per  
therm of the gas on the day of delivery.

16 2. Enforcement. Any person, firm, partnership or  
18 corporation who violates this chapter commits a civil violation  
for which a civil forfeiture of not more than \$500 for each  
20 subsequent offense may be adjudged. The Commissioner of  
Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources shall enforce this chapter  
22 pursuant to Title 7, section 14.

24 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

26 This bill requires suppliers of propane gas to give notice  
to persons who have requested gas of the per therm price of the  
28 gas on the day of the delivery.
