24	Sec. 18. Change in date of election of trustees. Whenever the term
24	of office of a trustee of the Gray Water District expires, that trustee shall serve until the successor is elected and
26	qualified. The trustee's successor is elected for a term of
	years, as provided by section 9 of the charter, at a special
28	election of the voters of the district, to be called and held or
	the same day as the annual municipal election. If the date of
30	the annual municipal election is changed and the change results
32	in the expiration of a trustee's term of office prior to the new date of the annual municipal election, the expiring term is
J &	extended to the new date of the annual municipal election. The
34	result of all elections for trustees must be declared by the
	moderator presiding at the meetings, and recorded by the town
36	clerk in the town clerk's records, and a certificate of the
	election must be filed by the town clerk with the trustees of the
38	district. It is the duty of the trustees to see that the
40	certificate is entered in the records of the district. The recorded certificate is sufficient evidence in all cases of the
*0	legality of the elections.

46	This amendment provides that a trustee's term continues until the trustee's successor is elected. This amendment also
18	changes the time when a trustee's election must be held from the
50	day of the annual town meeting to the day of the annual municipal election.
