An Act to Enhance the Trapping of Beaver.



	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7432, sub-§11, as amended by PL 1985, c. 369, §15, is further amended to read:
	11. Use or possession of prohibited implements or aids. A person is guilty, except as provided in subsection 14, paragraph
	B, of use or possession of a prohibited implement or aid if he that person:
,	
	A. Sets or tends a snare for the purpose of trapping any wild animal or wild bird, except that snares may be used to
	trap beaver;
	B. Sets or tends a swivel, pivot or set gun for the purpose of killing, taking, catching, wounding, harming or molesting any wild animal or wild bird;
	C. Deposits any poisonous or stupefying substance for the
	purpose of killing, taking, catching, wounding, harming or molesting any wild animal or wild bird; or
	D. Sells, advertises, gives notice of the sale or keeps for sale any swivel, pivot or set gun or poisonous substance for
	the taking of wild animals or wild birds.
	Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §7453-A is enacted to read:
	§7453-A. Trapping beaver
	1. Traps. A person may use snares when trapping beaver
	during the open beaver trapping season.
	2. Rules. All rules pertaining to the trapping of beaver with the so-called Conibear trap apply to the trapping of beaver
	with a snare.
	STATEMENT OF FACT
	This bill allows trappers to use a snare when trapping
	beaver. The bill provides that the rules that apply to the use of the so-called Conibear trap apply to the use of snares.
