24	Further amend the bill in section 4 in subsection 1 by striking out all of paragraph G (page 2, lines 19 to 24 in L.D.)
26	and inserting in its place the following:
28	'G. Rates or bill payment assistance programs for residential customers who have been certified eligible for
30	state or federal fuel assistance that take into account the difficulty these customers have paying in full for electric
32	service or that target assistance to these customers in the most efficient manner, taking into account the necessity of
34	maintaining electric service.'
36	Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

40	'FISCAL NOTE  This bill requires the Public Utilities Commission to
