IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE

An Act to Require a Driver Education Program Curriculum.

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#### Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §8702, as amended by PL 1989, c. 721, §1, is further amended to read:

6 §8702. Curriculum

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A driver education course offered in accordance with section 8 8701 shall must meet the curriculum requirements prescribed by 10 the commissioner,-include-both-classroom-instruction and practice driving-and-be-approved-by-the-ecommissioner---The-requirements 12 preseribed-by-the-commissioner-shall-be-no-less-rigorous-than-any similar-requirements-prescribed-by-the-Board-of-Commercial-Driver Education--and--the--requirements--of--Title--32---section--9602, 14 subsection--6 Secretary of State pursuant to Title 29, section 587. No state subsidy, state reimbursement for expenditures on 16 adult education programs or state reimbursement for adult vocational education programs may be paid with respect to any 18 driver education course that has not been approved by the 20 commissioner. At the request of the commissioner, the Board of Commercial Driver Education may assist the commissioner in 22 performing the commissioner's duties under this chapter.

Sec. 2. 29 MRSA §583, 2nd  $\P$ , as repealed and replaced by PL 1989, c. 878, Pt. G, §4, is amended to read:

A successful course completion certificate may be issued to any person permitted by law to have an operator's license or a 28 restricted license provided the course meets the special standards--adopted--by--the--Commissioner--of--Education7--of7--if 30 applicable --- the -- commercial -- driver -- education -- school -- licensing requirements-under-Title-32,--chapter-95 curriculum requirements 32 adopted pursuant to section 587. A successful course completion certificate shall may not be issued to any person who was not at 34 least 15 years of age at the commencement of the driver education course. 36

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Curriculum at Class A schools. The Class A school 4. 2 curriculum shall-consist-ef must include at least 30 hours of instruction and classroom 6 hours of behind---the---wheel 4 instruction behind-the-wheel and conform with curriculum requirements adopted pursuant to Title 29, section 587 before a б student may be issued a course completion certificate. Classroom instruction shall must be limited to not more than 4 hours in any 8 one 24-hour period. Instruction in motorcycle safety shall must conform to standards which-are established by the board. The 10 instructor and students are required to use seat belts during the behind-the-wheel instruction.

Sec. 5. 32 MRSA §9602, sub-§6, as enacted by PL 1989, c. 721, 14 §3, is amended to read:

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 6. Required instruction. Every In addition to conforming to curriculum requirements adopted pursuant to Title 29, section
 587, every commercial driver education school must inform its students of the existence and the practical purpose of handicapped parking laws and ordinances.
