STATEMENT OF FACT

Erma Painter of Augusta taught school for nearly 10 years before terminating her teaching position on July 19, 1976. As she did not have 10 years of service she was not "vested" which would have entitled her to apply for a retirement benefit under the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, section 17851.

This resolve waives the requirement in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, section 17851, that a member not in service have at least 10 years of creditable service to qualify for a retirement benefit.
