STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 115TH LEGISLATURE SECOND REGULAR SESSION

HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 998, L.D. 1447, Bill, "An Act Transferring County Jail Operations to the State"

Amend the amendment in section 1 by striking out all of subsection 6 (page 2, lines 31 to 44 and page 3, lines 1 to 6 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

'6. The commission shall study the feasibility of 22 transferring county jails to the State. As part of the feasibility study, the commission shall identify the respective 24 duties and responsibilities of the State and counties under the correctional system as they exist on the effective date of this 26 Act and as they could exist if a complete transfer of county jails to the State were to occur. The commission shall examine 28 and evaluate the feasibility of other alternative divisions of duties and responsibilities between the State and counties. The 30 commission shall determine the current and potential costs to the State, benefits to the counties and overall effect on the people of the State of all the options set out in this paragraph. 32

7. If the commission determines that a transfer of county jails to the State is feasible, it shall develop a method of implementing the transfer of the operations of county jails to the State, including a timetable for the transitional process. The commission shall include in its study the following issues:

- A. The degree to which duties and responsibilities should be transferred or shared between the State and counties;
- B. The functional role of county jails pertaining to who will be confined and for how long;
- 46 C. The degree to which the jails should have vocational, educational and work-release programs;

D. The mechanics of transferring bond obligations to the 50 State and the allocation of financial obligation for those bonds;

E. The transfer of seniority rights and eligibility of appointment to state positions for county jail employees, together with any related issues of collective bargaining rights; and

F. All statutory changes required to implement the transfer.'

Further amend the amendment in section 1 in subsection 9 in the 5th line (page 3, line 26 in amendment) by striking out the following: "for transferring county jails to the State" and in the 8th and 9th lines (page 3, lines 29 and 30 in amendment by striking out the following: "to implement the transfer of county jails to the State" and inserting in its place the following: 'as necessary to implement its recommendations'

STATEMENT OF FACT

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This amendment clarifies that before the commission may develop a plan to accomplish the transfer the commission must
first conduct a study of the feasibility of a transfer.
