Resolve, to Conduct an Independent Review of the Department of Human Services.

Sec. 1. Independent review. Resolved: That the Legislature is authorized to hire an independent management firm to conduct a complete review of the social service programs of the Department of Human Services to include:

 An assessment of current social service programs and services identifying any duplication of effort or inefficiencies in management and administration;

2. A review of the current payment system and procedures for contracted services, individuals, child support collections, day care providers and others who rely on financial support from the department and recommendations to streamline payment systems;

A review of the current service delivery system with
 recommendations for the establishment of a centralized,
 single-entry, one-client-family-to-one-worker approach to service
 delivery;

4. A review of expenditures of the department and recommendations for reducing administrative overhead;

5. An assessment of current management practices including consideration of measures to reduce delays in service provision;

6. A review of the rules promulgated by the department with the goals of reducing delays in the provision of services, unnecessary regulatory requirements, administrative costs and confusion for citizens, medical professionals and agencies;

7. Consideration of reducing the size of the department and

34 8. A review of current child protective services, to determine any needed revisions in approach to, coordination of,

Sec. 2. Report. Resolved: That the firm hired to conduct this review shall submit its report, together with any necessary implementing legislation, to the First Regular Session of the ll6th Legislature and to the Office of the Executive Director of the Legislative Council by November 1, 1992; and be it further

44 Sec. 3. Surcharge imposed; transfer of funds. Resolved: That a surcharge of 8% for fiscal year 1991-92 only may be assessed on special revenue collections of the Department of Human Services. 46 surcharge applies This to the following accounts of the 48 Department of Human Services: Account #04305.1, Human Services Administration; Account #04310.1, Bureau of Health; Account 50 · #04310.2, Special Revenue - Health; Account #04310.5, Control Over Plumbing;

Account #04310.6, Public Health Laboratory; Account #04315.1, Bureau of Medical Services; and Account #04185.5, Board of Certification of Water Treatment.

All revenue collected as a result of the 8% surcharge is transferred as undedicated revenue to the General Fund and must be transferred by June 30, 1992.

Once the amount of \$125,000 has been collected and transferred to the General Fund the surcharge will cease; and be it further

Sec. 4. Allocation. Resolved: That the following funds are allocated from the Department of Human Services to carry out the purposes of this resolve.
