This bill will allow rehired laid-off members who are close to retirement age to retire with repurchased service earlier than under current law. This provision will result in the elimination of an actuarial gain that would otherwise occur when older employees who are temporarily laid off withdraw their contributions. Any effect on future employer contribution rates will be negligible.'
