SENATE AMENDMENT " A" to S.P. 553, L.D. 1457, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Retirement Service Credits for Former Workers'
Compensation Commissioners Who Became Judges before December 1,
1984"

Amend the bill in the first line after the enacting clause
(page 1, line 3 in L.D.) by inserting at the beginning the
following: 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the
statement of fact the following:

'Sec. 2. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated
from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.



SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 553, L.D. 1457

2 This bill will affect one judge allowing that judge to
3 retire 1 1/2 years early. This change will increase the unfunded
4 actuarial reserve of the Maine Judicial Retirement System by
5 approximately \$34,000. The annual amortization payments will be
6 \$1,600. The Judicial Department will require additional General
7 Fund appropriations of \$1,200 in fiscal year 1991-92 and \$1,600
8 in fiscal year 1992-93 to fund these increased employer
9 contributions.'
