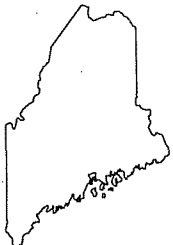

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

12 MRSA §7458, sub-§14-A is enacted to read:

6 14-A. Illegal use of firearm in Westport. A person is
8 guilty of illegal use of a firearm in Westport if that person
10 hunts deer with any firearm other than a shotgun or
12 muzzle-loading firearm in the town of Westport.

12 STATEMENT OF FACT

14 This bill bans the use of firearms, other than shotguns and
16 muzzle-loading firearms, for the hunting of deer in Westport.
