An Act to Require Eating Establishments That Have Outdoor Seating to Have Restrooms.



### Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §1685, sub-§1, as enacted by PL 1987, c. 8, §2, is amended to read:

1. Eating establishment. "Eating establishment" means an eating establishment licensed by the Department of Human Services under chapter 562 which prepares and serves food to the public for consumption inside the premises or provides exterior seating as described in section 1686. "Eating establishment" does not include catering establishments, establishments dispensing food solely from vending machines, pushcarts and mobile eating places, readside—stands,—retail—frozen—dairy—product—establishments—er any—other—such—places—where—customers—de—not—consume—food—inside the—building—where—the—feed—is—prepared—and—served.

Sec. 2. 22 MRSA §1686, first ¶, as repealed and replaced by PL 1987, c. 769, Pt. A, §73, is amended to read:

Unless it is licensed for fewer than 13 seats, or if it has fewer than 13 seats located outside the eating establishment for the purpose of consuming food and is not licensed for en-premise on-premises consumption of alcoholic beverages, an eating establishment shall must provide at least one toilet facility for the use of its customers. Toilet facilities which require access through the food preparation area or the use of which would in any way cause the establishment to be in violation of any state law or rule shall are not be considered as fulfilling this The location of the toilets shall must be clearly requirement. marked, maintained in a sanitary condition, in good repair and their location identifiable from the eating area. There shall may be no charge for their use. Lavatory facilities shall must be located within or immediately adjacent to all toilet rooms or vestibules.

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#### STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill expands the requirement for the provision of toilet facilities for the use of patrons to those restaurants which provide exterior seating.
