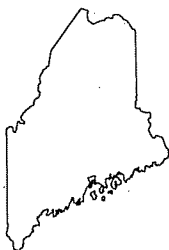

An Act to Provide for Clean-burning Diesel Fuel.



2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

4 Sec. 1. 10 MRSA §1663 is enacted to read:

6 §1663. Diesel fuel pump standards

8 Every gasoline station selling diesel fuel shall dispense diesel fuel only from pumps equipped with:

10 1. Filter system. A filter system to filter out dirt, water and other contaminants; and

12 2. Sight glass. A glass bowl, butterfly or other sight glass to permit visual inspection of the fuel at the pumps.

14 Sec. 2. Effective date. This Act takes effect December 31, 1992.

18 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

20 This bill requires gasoline stations to dispense diesel fuel
22 only from pumps equipped with filter systems and sight glasses to help ensure the use of clean-burning diesel fuel.
