An Act to Prohibit the Use of Stickers on Trespassing Motor Vehicles.



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

2
4 17-A MRSA §404, sub-§2-A is enacted to read:

6 2-A. The application of stickers or other devices to the
8 trespassing motor vehicle by the owner of the residential or
10 nonresidential property where that motor vehicle is located is
12 prohibited. This subsection does not apply to law enforcement
14 officers engaged in the performance of official duties.

12 STATEMENT OF FACT

14 This bill prohibits the owners of residential or
16 nonresidential property upon which motor vehicles are trespassing
from affixing stickers or other devices to the trespassing motor
vehicle.
