HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1011, L.D. 1479, Bill, "An Act to Protect the Copyright and Ownership Rights of Maine Artists"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in that part designated "§304." by striking out all of subsection 4 and inserting in its place the following:

'4. Application. This section does not apply to:

A. An agreement to publish an advertisement in a newspaper that is issued at least once each week; or

B. The duplication of a work of art under the fair use doctrine of federal copyright law, 17 United States Code, Section 107.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

The amendment exempts from the operation of the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 27, section 304, duplication of a work of art under the fair use doctrine of federal copyright law.
