COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " $\mathcal{H}$ " to H.P. 1013, L.D. 1481, Bill, "An Act to Facilitate the Delivery of Family Support Services"

Amend the bill in section 2 in that part designated "<u>\$1801.</u>" by striking out all of subsection 3.

Further amend the bill in section 2 in that part designated 20 "<u>\$1801.</u>" by renumbering the subsections to read consecutively.

22 Further amend the bill in section 2 by striking out all of that part designated "<u>\$1803.</u>" and inserting in its place the 24 following:

## 26 '<u>§1803. Family support policy coordination</u>

28 With the assistance and advice of the councils established in sections 1804 and 1805, the commissioner shall coordinate the 30 development and implementation of consistent family support policies and services among the department's bureaus. The 32 commissioner shall assign at least one person from each bureau to carry out the duties of this subchapter. The duties include but 34 are not limited to the following.

36 <u>1. Resource allocation.</u> Those persons assigned by the commissioner under this section shall make recommendations to the commissioner regarding the allocation or reallocation of family support resources among the bureaus.

2. Policy development and implementation. Those persons 42 assigned by the commissioner under this section shall develop and implement a family support policy that is consistent among the 44 bureaus. COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1013, L.D. 1481

Service coordination and monitoring. Those persons 3. 2 assigned by the commissioner under this section shall oversee service coordination for families who are served by more than one bureau and shall resolve interbureau disagreements. 4 4. Liaison to other departments. Those persons assigned by б the commissioner under this section shall serve as the department's liaison to other departments when a family is served 8 by more than one department.' 10 Further amend the bill in section 2 in that part designated "<u>\$1804.</u>" in the 2nd paragraph by striking out all of the last 12 sentence (page 4, lines 40 to 44 in L.D.). 14 Further amend the bill in section 2 in that part designated "<u>\$1805.</u>" in the first paragraph by striking out all of the last 16 sentence (page 5, lines 1 to 3 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following: 'The department shall provide appropriate 18 staff assistance to the council.' 20 Further amend the bill in section 2 in that part designated "<u>\$1805.</u>" in the 2nd paragraph in the 2nd line (page 5, line 6 in 22 L.D.) by striking out the following: "and the office" 24 Further amend the bill by inserting before the statement of 26 fact the following: **'FISCAL NOTE** 28 The costs to coordinate the development and implementation 30 of family support policy and fulfill the provisions of this bill will be absorbed within the budgeted resources of the various 32 bureaus of the Department of Mental Health and Mental Retardation. 34 The Department of Mental Health and Mental Retardation can absorb the costs associated with the Family Support Council 36 within budgeted resources.' 38 STATEMENT OF FACT 40 The amendment removes references in the bill to the Office of Family Support. The coordination envisioned by the original 42 bill will occur without establishing a separate office. The amendment also removes a provision that would have made regional 44 councils responsible family support for assisting the Commissioner of Mental Health and Mental Retardation to plan for 46 the implementation of court judgments such as the Augusta Mental 48 Health Institute decree. 50 The amendment adds a fiscal note to the bill.
