22	found to have abandoned a vehicle under this subsection is responsible for any towing charges that are directly related to
24	the abandonment of the vehicle.
26	FISCAL NOTE
28	This bill makes abandonment of a vehicle a civil violation.
30	The additional work load and administrative costs associated with a minimal number of new cases filed in District Court as a result
32	of the violation will be absorbed within the budgeted resources of the Judicial Department. There will be a minor increase in
34	General Fund revenue from the collection of additional fines.'
36	STATEMENT OF FACT
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40	This amendment makes abandonment of a motor vehicle a civil violation and makes the person who abandons a vehicle responsible for towing charges associated with that abandonment. The
