SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1026, L.D. 1499, Bill, "An Act to Improve Motorcycle Driver Education"


Amend the amendment by striking out all of the 3rd and 4th paragraphs after the title (page 1, lines 27 to 35 in amendment) and inserting in their place the following:

'Further amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 1 in the 2nd to 4th lines (page 1, lines 23 to 25 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "two members of the Joint Standing Committee on Transportation appointed by the committee chairs" and inserting in its place the following: 'four Legislators, one Senator appointed by the President of the Senate and 3 members of the House of Representatives appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives' . '

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment changes the composition of the study group to include one Senator appointed by the President of the Senate and 3 members of the House of Representatives appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives. The amendment removes the requirement that legislative members of the study group be members of th Joint Standing Committee on Transportation.
