COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " \mathcal{A} " to H.P. 1026, L.D. 1499, Bill, "An 14 Act to Improve Motorcycle Driver Education"

16 Amend the bill in section 1 in the first paragraph in the 5th line (page 1, line 10 in L.D.) by striking out the 18 following: "age or, after January 1, 1992, to any person," and inserting in its place the following: 'age,'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in the first paragraph 22 in the last 2 lines (page 1, lines 15 and 16 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "All licenses expire on December 31st of the 24 year of issue." and inserting in its place the following: 'All lieenses-expire-on-December-31st-of-the-year-of-issue.'

Further amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 1 in the 28 2nd line (page 1, line 23 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "two" and inserting in its place the following: 30 'four'

32 Further amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 1 in the 3rd line (page 1, line 24 in L.D.) by inserting after the 34 following: "Transportation" the following: ', one of whom must be appointed chair,'

Further amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 1 in the 38 6th line (page 1, line 27 in L.D.) by striking out the following: ", one of whom is elected to chair the study"

Further amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 2 in 42 paragraph A in the 2nd line (page 1, line 39 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "programs" and inserting in its place the 44 following: 'program's'

46 Further amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 2 in paragraph A in the last line (page 1, line 40 in L.D.) by 48 inserting after the following: "requirements" the following: 'and the feasibility of extending this requirement to drivers of 50 all ages'

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Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 3.

Further amend the bill by inserting before the statement of fact the following: 4

'FISCAL NOTE

Costs associated with the proposed study to determine potential improvements to the Motorcycle Driver Education Program including legislative per diem and member expenses will be absorbed within an existing federal highway safety grant allocation administered by the Department of Public Safety.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

18 This amendment deletes the provision in the bill requiring all motorcycle drivers to complete a driver education program in order to receive a license and make several changes in the 20 motorcycle driver education study established in the bill. The amendment also adds a fiscal note. 22
