HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1026, L.D. 1499, Bill, "An Act to Improve Motorcycle Driver Education"

Amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 2 in paragraph C in the last line (page 1, line 47 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "and"

Further amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 2 by striking out all of paragraph D (page 1, lines 49 and 50 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'D. The feasibility of requiring all first-time recipients of a motorcycle operator's license or learner's permit to have successfully completed a motorcycle driver education program; and

E. Any other issues the Secretary of State determines appropriate.'

Further amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 3 in the 2nd line (page 2, line 2 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "116th" and inserting in its place the following: 'Second Regular Session of the 115th' and in the same line by striking out the following: "1993" and inserting in its place the following: '1992'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment expands the charge to the motorcycle driver education study established in the bill and changes the reporting date for the study.
