An Act to Amend the Farm Truck Registration Laws.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 29 MRSA $\S246$, 6th \P , as repealed and replaced by PL 1987, c. 789, $\S11$, is amended to read:

The annual fee fees for registration of farm motor trucks, equipped with axles other than so-called dolly axles falling under section 1652, subsection 4, paragraph A, subparagraph (6), or farm motor trucks towing a trailer or semitrailer when those trucks are used primarily for transportation of agricultural commodities, supplies or equipment to be used in connection with the operation of a farm or farms owned, operated or occupied by the registrant, shall-be are as follows:

This bill extends the registration schedule for farm motor trucks from a maximum gross weight of 54,000 to 69,000 pounds, thus allowing tri-axle trucks used primarily for the transportation of agricultural commodities, supplies or equipment to be registered as farm motor trucks rather than commercial
