An Act to Compensate Landowners for Land Value Lost because of Wildlife Restrictions.



	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

8	A landowner is entitled to compensation from the State for
10	any loss in the value of a landowner's property if a proposed use
10	of the property has been denied or restricted in any way as a
	result of the application of section 480-D, subsection 3 or rules
12	adopted pursuant to that subsection. Compensation is determined
	by comparing the assessed value of the property prior to the
14	restriction compared to the assessed value of the property after
	the restriction has been imposed. The commissioner shall adopt
16	rules to implement this section.

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20	STATEMENT OF FACT
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22	This bill provides that the State must compensate a landowner if the value of the owner's property has been

24	diminished by the provision of the natural resources protection
26	laws that prohibits activities that harm significant wildlife
26	habitat. The Commissioner of Environmental Protection is
	instructed to adopt rules to provide compensation measured by the

loss in assessed value of the property.

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
