This bill provides tuition assistance to students pursuing a master's degree in social work at a private graduate school of social work accredited by the Council on Social Work Education. Under the bill, scholarships are awarded only to those persons who make a 5-year commitment to work with chronically mentally ill persons in Maine after receiving their degrees. Funding is provided for 80 student scholarships in fiscal year 1991-92 and fiscal year 1992-93.
