	This bill provides for funds to increase the State's
50	contribution for group accident, sickness or health insurance on
	behalf of eligible retired teachers. The State presently

provides 100% payment of group accident and sickness or health insurance on behalf of state employees. This bill provides parity between retired teachers and retired state employees by increasing the percentage of state payment of health insurance for retired teachers to 100%.

This bill also corrects an error created by Public Law 1989, chapter 878 that unintentionally omitted language intended for the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 20-A, section 13451, subsection 3 by adding that omitted language regarding school units that change their group accident and health insurance plan or provider and resolves a conflict created by 2 public laws affecting the same section of the law.
