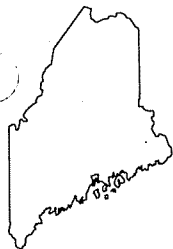

An Act to Amend the Reduction in Toxics in Packaging Laws.



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

32 MRSA §1734, sub-§3 is enacted to read:

5 3. Alcoholic beverages bottled prior to effective date.
6 The package or packaging component contains an alcoholic beverage
7 bottled prior to April 1, 1992.

10 STATEMENT OF FACT

12 This bill clarifies that the packaging of any alcoholic
13 beverages shipped into the State after April 1, 1992 must comply
14 with the requirements pertaining to reduction of toxics in
15 packaging and exempts from those requirements noncomplying
16 inventories of alcoholic beverages held in the State as of April
17 1, 1992.
