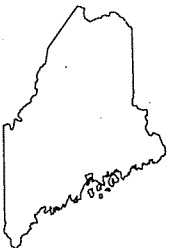

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An Act Concerning Radar Devices.

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2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **29 MRSA §1254, 2nd ¶ is enacted to read:**

6 An operator of a motor vehicle stopped by a law enforcement  
8 officer on any public way in this State for a violation of  
10 section 1251, 1252 or 1253 after the officer measured the speed  
12 of the operator's vehicle with a radar device has the right to  
14 see the measurement of the speed of the operator's vehicle  
16 indicated by the device. Failure to comply with an operator's  
18 request to observe the measurement is grounds for the dismissal  
20 of the complaint by the court.

#### 14 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

16 This bill amends the law to provide operators of motor  
18 vehicles stopped for speeding the right to see the speed  
20 measurement indicated by the law enforcement officer's radar  
device.
