29 MRSA §1254, 2nd ¶ is enacted to read:

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An operator of a motor vehicle stopped by a law enforcement officer on any public way in this State for a violation of section 1251, 1252 or 1253 after the officer measured the speed of the operator's vehicle with a radar device has the right to see the measurement of the speed of the operator's vehicle indicated by the device. Failure to comply with an operator's request to observe the measurement is grounds for the dismissal of the complaint by the court.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This bill amends the law to provide operators of motor vehicles stopped for speeding the right to see the speed measurement indicated by the law enforcement officer's radar device.
